Cyndi and I arrived back in Chimala along with **Dr. David Sullivan** in the third week of January and we will be here most of the month of February. It has been great to be back and

see how much work is being done concerning the spreading of the Gospel. In the three weeks we have been here, I have received reports of thirteen baptisms. The Radio Evangelism has now grown to two different programs being done on two different stations. One is being done and paid for by the Forest Church of Christ in Mbeya and the other one is being done in Mbozi. Six of the reported baptisms are the result of these programs.

The other seven baptisms have been the result of teaching people here around the mission. **Boaz Kasiba**, who is one of the elders at the mission congregation is a very dedicated man when it comes to teaching others the Truth. I was privileged to get to speak at both the morning and evening service last weekend at the mission congregation. We had a lady come forward wanting to be baptized. I later found out that Boaz has been studying with her. Not only had he studied with **Rebecca**, but he has also taught six other people that have been baptized in the last few weeks.

Many of you have heard me say this before, and it is still true just as it was in the time of Christ. He told us in John 4:35 “Do you not say ‘There are yet four months, and then comes harvest’? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look on the fields, they are white for harvest”. This is what led me to want to come here after my first trip in 1999 and I believe this verse is still as true today as it was then. **Bill Stinson**

2016 MEDICAL EQUIPMENT NEED

This year we have a major need and project which will require outside help. Our **X-ray equipment** is falling apart and is held together with paper clips and lots of welding. X-rays are still being developed with the old water tank system. Our goal is to replace our equipment with an updated machine and automatic processor. This new equipment will also require remodeling of the department. The cost of such under-taking will be significant and in my estimation over **\$100,000**. If you know of any hospital or medical facility that has equipment in good shape which they are replacing, please let me know or please talk to them to see if they would be willing to donate or sell to us at a lower rate. It is very difficult for us to pay for such equipment as we usually just break even each month financially. Chimala Bible Institute off to a Great Start

Our **Preacher's Training School** is off to its biggest start in many years. We have twenty two new first year students and eight returning second year students. These students represent many different areas of Tanzania and a couple of other east African countries. Our biggest influx of students this year are coming from the northern part of Tanzania from a region called Mwanza. These students represent a bigger challenge in teaching because they have come from an area where they have not been taught the whole truth. So far, they have been asking a lot of questions, but seem to understand when the scriptures are explained to them. We are looking forward to them going back to their homes and teaching others there the Truth.

We are continuing to get more phone calls from others that are wanting to join our school, but we decided that 30 students are the most we can house in our dorms currently. We are looking at the possibilities of building some newer facilities so we can increase the number of men we can train. With the church continuing to grow here in Tanzania, we feel confident that there are going to be more and more men that will need training. Timothy 2:2 is our motto of our school. When you consider the fact that our teachers at CBI are the men that helped lead the way for several hundred baptisms last year, we believe they are the right men to fulfill this role in sharing what they have learned.

Clean Water Project Completed at Our Schools

One of the projects I came to do was to get clean water for our students at the schools. This is something that was needed to be done for quite some time. In the beginning I did not believe that our well system would handle the demand, but after installing a new pump last year while we were here (thanks to Jim Gragg), I have decided it could possibly handle more demand. I designed a plan that will allow the students to have clean drinking water and assure the other areas will still have enough water. As I write this article, we have just today completed the work. I am sure there will need to be some fine tuning done, but we are happy to be this far. **Bill Stinson**
