At-A-Glance: Chimala School of Preaching

The most significant aspect of the Chimala Mission has always been in the training of preachers, evangelists and church leaders. All aspects of the mission are important, but preacher-training more closely fits the original purpose and direction of the mission's foundational principles as we continue the ultimate and eternal goal to "seek and to save that which is lost" (Luke 19:10). This emphasis is perhaps exhibited the most during the summer seminars and evangelistic campaigns, and in the weekend evangelism efforts of the Chimala School of Preaching.

This issue of the *Challenge of Africa* highlights some of this past summer's efforts and successes. There were a total of 13 baptisms--13 precious souls now a part of the eternal kingdom of God. In that we can surely rejoice! And while this number may not be as high as in years' past; we must remember the cyclical nature of seedtime and harvest.

Furthermore, Satan is increasing the sowing of the tares of modern secularism, materialism, and Islam. As CSOP director, Bernard Kulanga said in a recent department head's meeting: "It is easy to ask 70 questions in an hour, which will take a wise man to answer for 77 years." Much of the follow-up time after the outdoor campaign preaching was dedicated to answering listeners' questions. However, preparing our brothers and sisters in Christ--both young and old--to meet these challenges was evident, as we had 91 attendees at our youth seminar, 103 at our ladies' seminar, and 73 participants in our preachers' seminar. CSOP will continue to be the tip of the spear in spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ and defending God's religious, moral and ethical principles under which all people are amenable.
